Waterboro's 20/20 Master Planning Committee is actively working on a new Comprehensive Plan for the Town. Tom Ursia, Waterboro's Town Planner is working with a group of enthusiastic volunteer Committee members, which include: Bob Powers, Roger Macomber, Sandi Binette, Todd Abbott, Jack Seery, Kent Whitten and Steve Eveld.

The Committee's work is to provide the Town with a roadmap of the path the Town should take for the next 10 years and also provide action plans on how to achieve it's goals. It is anticipated it will take up to two years to complete the process. Through Mr. Ursia's efforts, Efficiency Maine granted the Town \$20,000.00, which will aid the Committee in producing an energy component of both the Plan and Action Plans segments.

The Committee is working on conducting three Visioning Sessions this fall. One with young adults, a general session and a third with senior citizens. Dates, times and locations will be announced.

All meetings of the Committee are open to the public and the Committee encourages them to attend. In order to produce the best Comprehensive Plan for the Town, public input is essential.

The next meeting will be held Wed., Sept. 8, 2010, 6 PM, at Waterboro's Central Fire Station on John Smith Road in Waterboro Center.
