

Note from Motor Vehicle Agent: all motorcycles should renew at *Town Offices* instead of *Rapid Renewal* for this first year of the change to March expirations as Rapid Renewal is experiencing problems with the changeover.

Notice: New Law Requires Motorcycle Registrations in March



Last session, the Maine State Legislature passed LD 221, effective March 1, 2012.

This law requires the INSPECTION STICKER on a motorcycle to be displayed on the license plate in the UPPER, LEFT-HAND CORNER.

To accommodate this, Motor Vehicle has changed the expiration date to March for ALL motorcycles needing an inspection sticker, then created a REGISTRATION YEAR STICKER with "MARCH" on it just for motorcycles. This sticker will go in the UPPER, RIGHT-HAND CORNER.

Starting March 1, 2012, all motorcycles subject to inspections will have a March expiration. Registration and excise fees will be pro-rated to adjust to the new date as they come in to be registered or re-registered until next March when all will be caught up and on the same schedule.

NOTE: This DOES NOT mean that you to come in now!

Just follow your normal inspection / registration cycle and you will be pro-rated to the next March AT THAT TIME.
