## **Memo**

**TO:** Municipal Agents

---

On January 1, 2011, the Bureau of Motor Vehicles will continue to require a Certificate of Title for vehicles that are model year 1995 and newer.

The legislature amended the title law (Title 29-A, § 652) to say that vehicles with a model year 1994 or older will always be title exempt and Certificates of Title will not be issued because of this exemption.

This is a change in title application procedures because the requirement to title 1995 vehicles will carry forward in 2011 and future years.

The application to Re-issue a Certificate of Title (form MVT-8) was revised in June 2010 to reflect this change. These forms will be available to you as you deplete your current stock.
