## **FREE Screening & Discussion Series**

Be part of the next phase of our [Recovery in Maine](#) program, which uses free documentary screenings and community discussions to confront the opioid crisis in our state.

Recovery in Maine is a partnership between [Maine Behavioral Healthcare](#), [MaineHealth](#) and [Points North Institute](#), and we are working together to organize four upcoming events in Portland, Biddeford, Brunswick and Sanford.

The details of the tour are below. Each event will begin with a screening of the film [RECOVERY BOYS](#) by Oscar-nominated director Elaine Sheldon. The film takes an intimate look at the lives of four men as they attempt to reinvent their lives and mend broken relationships after years of drug use.

These screenings will be followed by panel discussions with local leaders working on the front lines of the epidemic. Our first series of screenings -- in Mid-coast Maine in July 2018 -- demonstrated how a film screening combined with a locally-grounded community forum can go a long way towards raising awareness, breaking down the stigma associated with addiction, and building stronger connections between people and resources.
