SUMMER CAMPS

Fill your child's summer with fun in our great camp programs! By popular demand we've made our Summer Day Camp and Teen Adventure Camp 7 weeks this year.

Summer Day Camp takes place at Massabesic Middle School and takes 3 field trips plus weekly trips to Bunganut Lake. Breakfast and lunch are included and cost is \$850 for 7 weeks (\$875 non-residents), 8am-4pm. Early drop off and late pick up are available for an additional fee. For students entering 1st through 6th grade, begins June 24.

Vacation Fun Camp is held at Old Town Hall and provides coverage for two weeks: August 12-16 and August 19-23. Cost is \$140 per week and space is limited.

Teen Adventure Camp heads out on an adventure every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday for 7 weeks of the summer beginning July 2. YOUTH TURKEY HUNTING SEMINAR

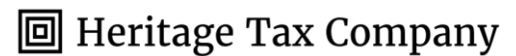
