

## ***PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION ORDINANCE***

### **Section 1:**

Establishment: Pursuant to M.R.S.A. Const. Art. The 111-A, 30 M.R.S.A. s1917 and 30 M.R.S.A. s3853, the Town of Waterboro hereby establishes the Waterboro Parks and Recreation Commission.

### **Section 2:**

- A. Appointment to the Commission shall be made by the Municipal Officers.
- B. The Commission shall consist of seven (7) members.
- C. The members shall be residents of the Town of Waterboro.
- D. The term of each member shall be the following:
  - 1. Two terms for one year.
  - 2. Two terms for two years.
  - 3. Three terms for three years.

### **Section 3:**

Subject to approval by the Board of Selectmen, the Commission shall have the following duties: A. Responsibility for the care, maintenance and activities at the Town's parks, beaches and recreational areas. B. Responsibility for the Town's recreational program. C. Direct the expenditure of all monies appropriated or available to carry out the purposes of the Ordinance.

### **Section 4:**

Severability: If any portion of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid, it shall not affect any other portion of the Ordinance.

### **Section 5:**

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective when enacted by the Legislative body of the Town of Waterboro. Enacted at the Special Town Meeting held June 7, 1983

- A) Care, maintenance and activities at the Town's parks, beaches and recreational areas:

- C) Expenditure of all monies appropriated or available to carry out the purposes of the Ordinance and Parks and Recreation Program
