



WAIVER FOR EXTENDED SNOW REMOVAL

- 1) All roads must meet either 1972 or 1984 standards to be approved by September 30, 2002.
- 2) Sample of release deed must be provided with legal backup by September 30, 2002.
- 3) Right of way must be surveyed by a licensed land surveyor and a plan submitted to the town or all land owners abutting the right of way must agree to deed 25' left and 25' right of the center line to the Town of Waterboro, by September 30, 2002.
- 4) Roads that the property owner believes to be properly graveled must have this road reviewed by the Road Review Committee and have a signed statement from the committee that all necessary culverts have been installed. Test pits to determine the depth of the gravel must be done at least every 100 ' and that the road gravel width must meet the appropriate standard by September 30, 2002.
- 5) Roads that have not been improved must have the 50' right of way cleared to its limit by September 30, 2002.
- 6) Roads that have been cleared by September 30, 2002 must be grubbed, graveled and all drainage installed by September 1, 2003 and paved by October 30, 2003
- 7) Roads that have been already graveled and have their layout done by September 30, 2002 must be paved by September 1, 2003 and ready to meet all Town approvals.
