

TOWN OF WATERBORO STORM POLICY

Waterboro Municipal Officers including the Town Hall, Library and Transfer Station will remain open on storm days unless closed by order of the Town Administrator.

In the absence of the Town Administrator, the Deputy Town Administrator shall make the decision. In the absence of the Town Administrator and Deputy Town Administrator the Chairman of the Board of Selectmen shall make the decision.

When the Administrator deems that weather conditions present a real safety risk to citizens and employees even with increased caution and slowed driving he/she may close nonessential Town services.

The decision of closing nonessential town services should be made after contact with the Road Commissioner and/or snowplow contractor and with other municipality's closings.

In the event that the Governor declares a State of Emergency, all nonessential services shall be closed.

The Administrator has the authority to open services when the weather conditions improve enough that the hazards no longer exist. This could apply to late openings of the Town Office, Library or Transfer Station when the storm abates during the day.

The Selectmen believe that Town business should continue as scheduled when ever possible.
