The Waterboro Town Clerk's office is now accepting Absentee Ballot Requests for the upcoming November 02nd, 2021 State Referendum Election.

Absentee ballot requests may be in writing, by phone, online, or in person. However, if you are asking to receive your ballot by mail, please request it early enough to allow for postal mail delivery time – both to receive it and return it (at least 4-5 days each way).

- You can request an absentee ballot by calling your Municipal Clerk's office at **207-247-6166**, each person requesting needs to speak to the clerk personally.
- You may also request an absentee ballot online or by mail from the Secretary of State's website: <https://www1.maine.gov/cgi-bin/online/AbsenteeBallot/online-form.pl>.
The SOS will then inform the town clerk to mail you an absentee ballot.
- Printed ballots will be available by the first week of October. Once received, requested ballots will be issued as soon as possible.
- We recommend returning ballots as soon as possible, preferably by Thursday October 28th, 2021.
- There will be NO Absentee Voting on Friday October 29th and Monday November 01st.
- Ballots MUST be returned to the municipal clerk no later than 8:00 pm on Election Day.
