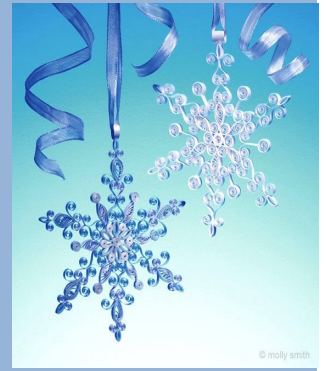

Summer Camp



Summer Camp: For children entering K-6th grade in the Fall. Camp runs June 29-August 14, M-F 8am-4pm. \$850.00 resident, \$875.00 non-resident for one child. For two children \$1500 resident , \$1550 non-resident. Early Drop-off (6am)and Late Pick-Up (6pm) is available. Early drop off is \$25.00 week, per child, and Late Pick-up is \$25.00 a week, per child.
